Tithing/Offering envelopes are now available to be picked up in the foyer. Please check at the table for your box.

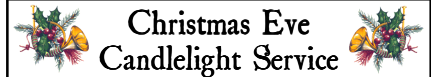
If you have an envelope number but your box is not there, please notify the office as soon as possible.
